How many of the candidates shortlisted against OBC category avails the benefit of the Reservation more than once for the post of Scientist-B (Botany)	The information furnished by the CPIO is found to be in order. Out of the 2 posts of Scientist-B in the Botany specialization advertised, 1 (one) post was reserved for OBC category. It was decided to shortlist the candidates for interview in the ratio of 1:5 based on the performance in the written test. Accordingly, the top 5 OBC category candidates in the merit list were called for interview. However, it may be noted that the candidates shortlisted against post reserved for OBC category can also compete against unreserved post provided they fulfill the criteria adopted for unreserved post. Accordingly, the list of candidates called for interview is enclosed.	Present reply
